



### **Expanded Face Covering Rules**

The SF Health Officer has announced expanded rules about where and when to wear face coverings. You must wear face coverings in more situations, especially when you are within 6 feet of people you don't live with, even if you are outside. The new rules also require that you wear a face covering when:

Passing people on the sidewalk:

- Passing people on a hiking trail or outdoors;
- When indoors, if others might use the space later, even if you're alone.

When at work or in a shared space, you must wear a face covering:

- In a common area (elevator, laundry room, break rooms, lobbies, hallways, bathrooms);
- When working in a cubicle or conference room;
- When working at a desk you share with another person on different days;
- When working around shared equipment.

Also, new to the order, children over age 9 must wear a face covering, like adults do. If they can, children 2 to 9 years old should try to wear a face covering. Children under 2 still do not need to wear a face covering. If you can't wear a medical or fabric mask, you are still required to wear something over your nose and mouth to block droplets, such as a bandana, gaiter, or face shield.

### **Be Counted -- Complete the US Census!**

Beginning August 11, US Census workers will begin visiting households that have not responded to the census. You can minimize the need for census takers to follow-up in person by responding to the census now—online, by phone, or by mail. The 2020 Census is safe, secure, and confidential. Data from the 2020 Census will be used to distribute hundreds of billions of dollars in federal funds each year that support education, health care, emergency services, housing and food assistance, and more!
